

Norwich School's under-18 boys hockey team have progressed to the quarter-finals of the England Hockey Board Boys U18 Schools Cup.

They will face Queen's College, Taunton in the next round, after

beating Cambridge-based Perse School in the fourth round of the eastern region stage of the competition.

After beating Perse 3-2 – thanks to two goals from Henry Laming and the other from Harry Cresswell – the team put themselves in the

national draw with the top eight schools in the country.

The winners of the quarter-finals will meet at Lee Valley Hockey and Tennis Centre, at the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park in London, on April 26-27 for the semi-finals and final.
